Matches will consist of two halves of 10 minutes with a three minute interval under the jurisdiction of a central timekeeper. Teams will consist of six players a side with unlimited substitution within the boundaries of each individual age group.

More importantly we encourage you to highlight the family aspect of the picnic including grandparents, friends and relatives ( a recruitment possibility ). We would like to see your Club well represented.

It is an ideal opportunity for the youngsters to mix socially with current players and players of the past and realise that lacrosse can be a lifetime pleasurable involvement.

At Whiteman Park there are many attractions including train rides, museums to visit, a wildlife park and bush walks etc etc.

We expect to have our own clown handing out lollies throughout the picnic to the children. We will also have some quality fruit available.
