BYLAWS

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Club rules (Constitution) take precedent over bylaws when a conflict exists.

Guidance Note – Status of By-laws - A by-law must be consistent with the Act, the regulations and these rules. The rules of an association bind the association and the members as an enforceable contract between them. By-laws may not have that status. Therefore, the use of by-laws should be reserved for more procedural or administrative matters.

1. Club Colours

Club major colours are black and yellow with minors brown and blue.

2. Membership

(1) Membership is open to everyone who has an interest in Western Australian Lacrosse.

3. Membership Categories

(1) Ordinary annual financial member

(2) Ordinary Lifetime Financial Member

(3) Life Membership

To be nominated a person may have been a member of the club for in excess of 20 years, served on the executive, and made a significant contribution to the Club.

The nomination to be proposed by the Executive and receive formal approval by a majority of members at an AGM.

Recognition to be recorded on Club letterhead and other electronic Club publications.

Life Members are entitled to add the title Life Member to the Club membership badge.

4. Subscription

Membership subscription to be decided by the Committee annually and recorded in the Club Policy document.

5. Club Policies

Policies must not be inconsistent with the Rules or Bylaws and the Secretary shall keep a written record of all policies approved by the committee.

6. Affiliation with LacrosseWA

When Kuljak Lacrosse Club is affiliated with LacrosseWA and LacrosseWA gives Kuljak an entitlement to vote at LacrosseWA meetings the authorization to do so must be given to the Club Executive, annually at the Kuljak AGM or any other Special General Meeting.

7. Kuljak Lacrosse Club – Western Australian Lacrosse Hall of Fame

The association (Kuljak Lacrosse Club) establish, maintain and retain a Hall of Fame that accords recognition of outstanding players (athlete), coaches, game officials, administrators and others who have made a significant contribution to the sport of lacrosse in Western Australia.

An Inductee to the West Australian Lacrosse Hall of Fame is to be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Hall of Fame Policy created and maintained by Kuljak Lacrosse Club.
